

Experienced Traction Linesman - Contract

Role Overview:

We are on the hunt for dedicated Electrical Line Mechanics to join a team in the Wellington region. This role involves installing, maintaining, and repairing traction electrical sub-transmission and overhead line systems, with a strong emphasis on teamwork and professionalism.

You will be working outdoors with 1500Vdc electrical components at heights, performing medium to heavy physical tasks, including working from EWP buckets and transporting equipment. ***Adherence to Health and Safety, Environmental, and Quality Assurance procedures is essential.***

This role is suitable for someone who is available for 1 – 2 weeks a month for approximately 5 months.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Engage in medium to heavy work primarily from EWP buckets or platforms.
- Install and maintain electrical cables and systems in compliance with safety standards.
- Collaborate effectively with project personnel to ensure successful task completion.
- Work outdoors with low voltage components while adhering to Health and Safety, Environmental, and Quality Assurance procedures.
- Maintain tools and equipment in excellent condition to ensure optimal performance.
- Transport equipment and materials throughout the work area.
- Perform tasks that require stretching, bending, and twisting, and lift heavy materials and tools.
- Wear necessary PPE.

Requirements:

- **Elevated Work Platform (EWP) licence and experience is essential**
- New Zealand driver's licence (classes 1, 2 & 4 preferred).
- Experience with 1500Vdc Overhead Lines is preferable.
- **Willingness to work various shifts, including nights and weekends.**

Personal Attributes:

- Strong team player with excellent communication skills.
- Detail-oriented, able to manage multiple tasks efficiently.
- Demonstrate mechanical aptitude and competency.
- High level of accuracy and attention to detail.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Registered traction linesman or electrician is preferred.
- Experience with overhead lines (traction) 1500Vdc is preferable.
- Commitment to obtaining New Zealand OHL certification.

To be considered for this role you will be eligible to work in New Zealand (must have valid work permit). Following an interview and reference checks, if successful, you will need to pass a pre-employment medical, drug and alcohol screening.
